Richard Davis received his Ph.D. degree in Mathematics from the University of California at San Diego in 1979 and has held academic positions at MIT, Colorado State University. He was Hans Fischer Senior Fellow at the Technical University of Munich (2009-12), Villum Kan Rasmussen Visiting Professor at the University of Copenhagen (2011-13), and Chalmers Jubilee Professor at Chalmers University of Technology. His research interests include time series, applied probability, extreme value theory, heavy-tailed modeling with applications to network models, and spatial-temporal modeling. Richard Davis is a fellow of the Institute of Mathematical Statistics and the American Statistical Association, and is an elected member of the International Statistical Institute.

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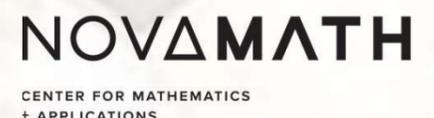
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
